AUSSIE PARSLEY
Apium prostratum



This new Australian Parsley is vigorous, low-growing, perennial herb to 1m in diameter. It has been selected for its unusual broad-leaf form and intense Parsley/Celery flavor. Aussie Parsley is native along coastal foreshore areas and some inland waterways of Australia.



CULTIVATION

Aussie Parsley is an adaptable herb preferring light to medium textured soils and adequate water. It will withstand full sun, but produces better quality leaves and stems if given partial shade in Summer. Aussie Parsley withstands full coastal foreshore Exposure and tolerates moderate frosts and alkaline soil conditions.

Regular harvesting and pinching out runners and flower stems will ensure that the plant remains compact and highly productive for several years. Aussie Parsley benefits from a handful of organic fertilizer (eg. Blood and Bone) in the bottom of the hole at planting (not in direct contact with roots) And frequent side dressings during the growing season.



DESCRIPTION

Aussie Parsley The glossy-green leaves are similar in shape to common Parsley. Clusters of small white-cream flowers occur for long periods through Summer and Autumn.



USES

Aussie Parsley is a delicious herb, with an intense Parsley/Celery flavor. Leaves may be picked at any time of the year and are used as a garnish or to flavor salads, soups, seafood, stews and casseroles.
